



The Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation Privacy Policy

The Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation's privacy policy governs personal information entered on our internet site in addition to the information that is sent to us through the mail and communicated by phone, facsimile, or email transmissions.

Our commitment is to secure all information that is given or transferred to the foundation. Physical, electronic and managerial procedures have been employed to safeguard the security and integrity of personal information.

Personal Information Collected Online

The Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation collects personal information online, including names, postal and e-mail addresses, phone and facsimile numbers, and billing information. We also collect business information from sole proprietorships that donate or request to receive information from the foundation. This information may include personal information, as well as personal information from individuals acting solely in their business capacity.

How The Nevada Childhood Cancer Foundation Uses Personal Information Collected Unless you otherwise consent, we will use your personal information only for the purpose for which it is submitted, such as to reply to your emails, process donation and business requests related to foundation events and programming, and to provide updates and foundation notices of events and important news. The foundation will not publish, loan, rent or sell personal or business information provided to us.

The Foundation may release personal information under the following circumstances:

- Where release is required by law (for example, a subpoena) or regulation or is requested by a government agency
- Where our records indicate a company may be engaged in fraudulent activity or other deceptive practices that a governmental agency should be made aware
- To appropriate persons, where your communication suggests possible harm to others
